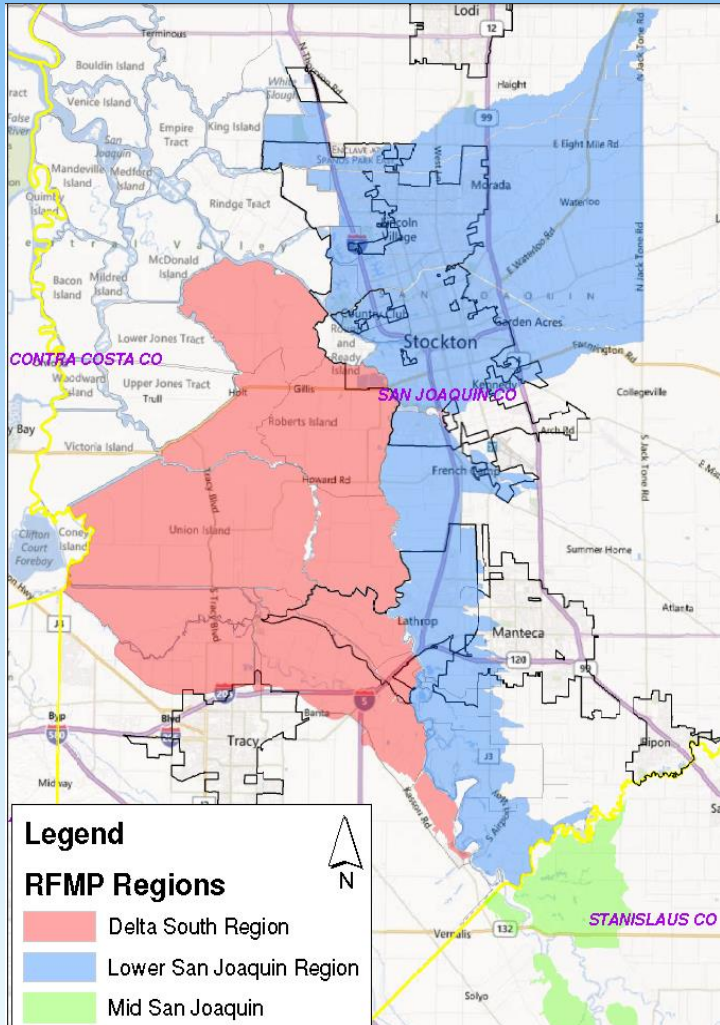

Reminders as We Approach Finish

Flood Management:

- 2012 CVPFF – broad vision for Central Valley
- RFMP
 - ✓ DWR funded
 - ✓ Long-term, local vision
- DWR's BWFS – System view - larger system components



RFMP – Reminder of what it is

It is:

1. Local 25 yr “master plan” for flood management
2. Developed from **existing information** and stakeholder interaction
3. Deliverable is a Report:
 - a) Description of problems
 - b) List of projects, categorized into 3 tiers (0-5 yr, 6-12 yr, 13+ yr horizons) for implementation
 - c) Financing plan for each project – champion, ability to pay local share, potential funding sources

It is not:

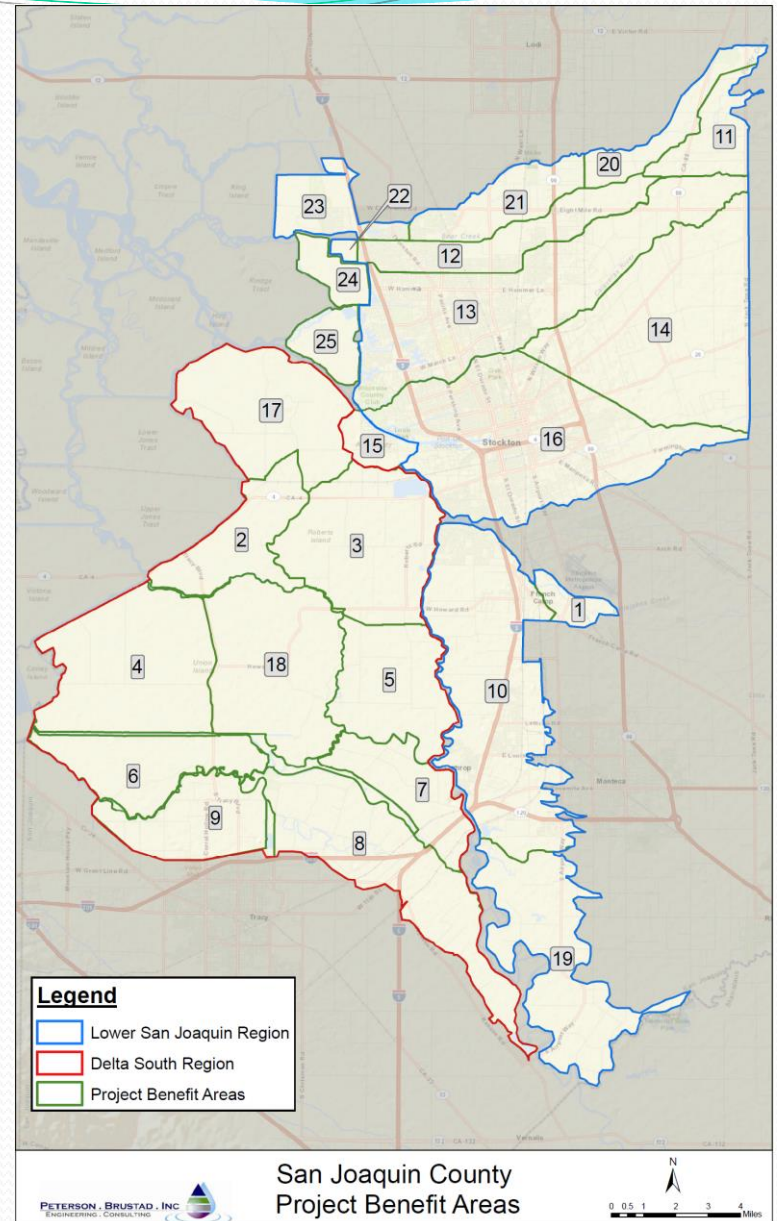
1. A feasibility-level assessment
2. A sector of the CVFPP, Conservation Strategy, or Federal plan

RFMP – Benefits to Regions

1. Communication - Discussions and understanding among the many diverse groups
2. Realistic target levels for flood protection
3. Greater level of detail than could be included within the scope of the 2012 CVFPP
4. Improved understanding about funding needs
5. Focused attention of funding partners and permitting agencies
6. Opportunity to influence BWFS and 2017 CVFPP

Status

- Refining projects and implementation order
- Preparing finance plan
- Working to streamline draft RFMP
