PROJECT DESCRIPTION: **The work performed under this Contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and supervision for:**

The Smith Canal Gate Project will include a fixed cellular sheetpile floodwall, miter gate structure including temporary in-water works and shoring, improvements to Dad's Point, and additional access improvements to the Stockton Golf and Country Club. Complete details and requirements for the improvements are provided in the Plans and Specifications.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held for the purpose of reviewing and answering questions regarding this project. Any interested contractor or his/her agent may attend - attendance is mandatory. Contractors must ensure that their company name and company representative name is recorded on the sign-in sheet provided at the meeting. Representatives of SJAFCFA will be present for questions.

An optional pre-bid inspection and walk-through will be held after the mandatory pre-bid meeting. Any interested contractor or his/her agent must coordinate their own access to the site.

Award of this contract requires the bidder to have a valid California contractor's license with the classifications identified above. These requirements shall be met at the time of the bid opening. Award of the contract also requires the bidder to demonstrate, to the satisfaction of SJAFCFA, that the bidder possesses the experience required to perform the work specified in the contract. Bidders are required to submit Bid Form Attachment C - Bidders Experience Questionnaire with their bid.

Each bid must also be accompanied by security for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid in the form of a bid bond issued by a corporate surety, a certified check or cashier's check payable to SJAFCFA, or cash.

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and a Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to SJAFCFA, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

SJAFCFA encourages the submission of bids and sub-bids by veteran-owned, minority-owned and womenowned business enterprises.

This is a public works project in accordance with Section 1720 of the California Labor Code. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of
